



PAIKIASOTHY SARVANAMUTTU

Sarvanamuttu received his Ph.D and first degree from the London School of Economics (LSE), University of London in 1986 and 1979 respectively.

Sarvanamuttu is a Co-Convenor of the Centre for Monitoring Election Violence (CMEV) and a Member of the Board of the Sri Lanka Chapter of Transparency International as well as a Member of the Advisory Board of the Berghof Foundation for Peace Support, Berlin, Germany, the UNDP Regional Centre on Governance, Bangkok, Thailand and the Sri Lanka Advisory Group of the Asia Pacific Leadership Forum on HIV/AIDs and Development. He has been quoted widely in the domestic and international media on the political situation in Sri Lanka, has presented papers and been a frequent participant at a number of international conferences on governance and security issues.

In 2002, Sarvanamuttu delivered the Gandhi Memorial Oration on the invitation of the India - Sri Lanka Society. A year later in 2003 he made the civil society presentation at the June 2003 Tokyo Donor Conference on Sri Lanka, at the invitation of the Government of Japan. From September -November 2004, Sarvanamuttu was in the USA on an Eisenhower Fellowship.

He has presented papers at international conferences on security and democracy in Sri Lanka and the developing world, and is quoted widely in the local and international media on contemporary Sri Lankan politics.
