Tenzing Lamsang is the CEO of The Bhutanese paper in Bhutan and is also an investigative journalist. The Bhutanese newspaper focuses on serious journalism that aims to influence not only readers but also government policy.

After graduating from Stephens' College (Delhi University) with History Honours in 2006, he worked as a reporter with the Indian Express newspaper in Delhi from 2006-2008. Between 2008 and 2010, Lamsang joined Bhutan's national newspaper Kuensel as the Chief Reporter.

From 2010 to mid 2011, he was the News Editor of Bhutan's first Business Paper Business Bhutan after which he left to launch The Bhutanese. It was here that he won Bhutan's best investigative journalist award in 2010. The Bhutanese has been at the forefront of the Bhutanese media, breaking not only some of the biggest stories but also delving into several sensitive issues. Lamsang is interested in issues of transparency, corruption, good governance, economy and business, and strategic issues. As a journalist, he has done several in depth stories on the above topics strengthening the democratic and intellectual discourse in Bhutan.
